

OFFICIAL PHOTO CONTEST RULES

Please read the complete contest rules before entering. No purchase or payment necessary to enter or win.

Photo Formats

Entries must be digital images. Please read the specific guidelines for submitting digital images.

Photographer/Copyright

Entries must be submitted by the original photographer. Do not submit a photo taken by someone other than yourself. You must be the sole owner of the copyright of any image submitted. Your submission of the photo and entry form is your guarantee that you are the author and copyright holder of the photo.

Number of Entries

An individual may submit up to three photos per contest.

Photo Subject Restrictions

Photos must be appropriate for posting on Sarasota Medieval Fair website. Obscene, provocative or otherwise questionable content will not be considered. Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. retains sole discretion as to what constitutes inappropriate content.

Ownership/Use Rights

Photographers retain the copyright to their photographs. By entering the contest, photographers agree to have their submitted photograph displayed on the Sarasota Medieval Fair website without any fee or other form of compensation, and agree that Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. may display winning photos in a photo gallery and in any future advertisement for Sarasota Medieval Fair and may make and retain copies of the photograph for archival purposes. Posted photos will be subject to the Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. website photo use policy. Photos will be credited to the photographer named in the entry form. Entries (including non-winning entries) may be selected for display or use in Sarasota Medieval Fair web pages, without permission from the photographer. Entries will never be used by Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. in any manner for sale. In the event that ownership of any photograph submitted to Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. is contested in any manner, Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. retains the discretion to disqualify that photograph and discontinue use of the photograph.

How to Enter

Digital photos may be submitted via email to Info@SarasotaMedievalFair.com with the subject line: 2019 Photo Contest (see further instructions below). Each photographer can submit up to 3 photos (submitting more photos is encouraged but only up to 3 photos, that you indicate, will be considered for the contest). Emails must include photographer contact information and camera information used. Please attach digital photos to the email. Entries must be received by December 15, 2019, at 11:59 p.m. EDST. Winners will be selected and announced in the Summer of 2020.

Judging

Entries will be judged on the basis of creativity, photographic quality, and effectiveness in conveying the unique

character of the Sarasota Medieval Fair. A Sarasota Medieval Fair, Inc. panel will judge the entries and all contest decisions are final. Entries that fail to comply with the Official Contest Rules will be disqualified

Winners

Judges will select a first, second and third place winning photo. In addition, three honorable mention winners will be selected. Winners will be notified by the Summer of 2020 by email, using the information on the entry form. Winning photographs, along with the photographer's name, email address (optional) and information about the photo will be displayed on the Sarasota Medieval Fair website and winning prints will be displayed at the Sarasota Medieval Fair and 11x 18 Prints will be displayed at the 2020 Sarasota Medieval Fair.

Compensation is provided to winners:

1ST Place - \$75.00 & Four Tickets to next year's Sarasota Medieval Fair

2nd Place - \$50.00 & Two Tickets to next year's Sarasota Medieval Fair

3rd Place - \$35.00 & Two Tickets to next year's Sarasota Medieval Fair

Honorable Mention - Two Tickets to next year's Sarasota Medieval Fair

Digital images should be submitted via email. Images should be formatted to 300 dpi, no larger than 1600 by 2400 pixels. Images should be submitted in JPG (at high quality). Digital images will not be returned.
